Those who score less than 10 marks in Level-1 test will not be eligible to appear for Level-2 exam. For Level 1 : Objective Type Questions will be based on General Knowledge, Test of Reasoning, General awareness about Department of Atomic Energy Activities etc.

For Level 2 : Paper-I and Paper-II written tests will be as per the syllabus published in the advertisement.

It may be noted that this Centre's website www.barcrecruit.gov.in is under up-gradation. Hence, 'Admit Card-Cum-Call Letter' of the individuals have been sent by post. In case of non-receipt of the same by April 15, 2017, candidates may communicate the same to us on our email ID : niyukti3@barc.gov.in or rect3@barc.gov.in. In such cases, candidate may directly come to Mumbai for writing the screening/written test where duplicate 'ADMIT CARD-CUM-CALL LETTER' will be issued to the candidate before commencement of the exams.

Candidate is required to paste his/her latest coloured photograph at the ear-marked space in the 'ADMIT CARD-CUM-CALL LETTER' and get it attested from any Gazetted Officer for confirming his/her identity.

All the candidates are requested to bring their original documents along with a copy of each along with them.

Instructions for Candidates

(A) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Outstation candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their stay in Mumbai.
 2. The candidate should be present at-least one hour before commencement of examination at his/her examination centre.
 3. **Entry to the examination Hall will not be allowed without this Admit Card-cum-Call Letter. The candidate should also bring alongwith them valid photo ID proof such as Aadhar Card / Election Card / PAN Card / Driving License / Passport etc.**
 4. Candidates are required to preserve this Admit Card cum Call Letter for both the days' written examination.
 5. Electronic devices/Cellular phones/Mobile/Pager/Calculator etc shall not be allowed in the examination hall.
 6. Your Application Number is your Roll Number.
 7. Candidates are required to bring the following documents & testimonials (original + copy of each):-
 - a) Print out of online application form
 - b) Educational qualifications (SSC/ HSC/ Graduation/ Post Graduation/ PhD)
 - c) Diploma/Certificate Course in translation
 - d) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC)
 - e) Original Institutional Copy of Bank Challan payment made before the closing date of receipt of online application)
 - f) Experience Certificate
 - g) Certificate of Medium of Education / Examination
 - h) "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from present employer in case of candidate working in Central / State Government / Public Sector Undertaking
 - i) Physically Handicapped Certificate for One Leg affected (OL) / Partially Deaf(PD) showing minimum 40% disability. Hearing Impairment (Partially deaf) means loss of 60 decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.
- Copies of documents will be collected by the Invigilators after verification. Candidates who do not submit the same will not be permitted to appear for the Level-2 examination.
8. OBC candidates seeking reservation under OBC category may please ensure that the caste name is included in the Central List of OBC by the Government of India. For details, candidates may visit website www.ncbc.nic.in. Candidate will not be allowed to appear for written examination if the caste name is not listed in the Central List of OBC. Candidates belonging to OBC category may please note that they have to bring the latest OBC Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the Central Government format. The OBC Non-Creamy Layer Certificate format can be downloaded from the website www.ncbc.nic.in.
 9. If there is any change in name due to marriage etc., relevant documents such as Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree, any legal document supporting change of name should be submitted.
 10. The eligibility of the candidate to appear for the written examination will be adjudged on the basis of self-declaration of the candidate given in the application.

11. SC / ST candidates from outstation who are not employed in Government Sector, etc. and not in receipt of Railway concession will be paid travelling allowance as per rules for attending this examination on production of valid Caste Certificate and ticket(s) / ticket Nos / Boarding pass, if travelled by Air. TA form can be downloaded from the BARC website. Duly filled-in TA form along with copy of Caste Certificate, ticket(s) & copy of cheque leaf / Bank passbook should be submitted at the time of written examination. Please mention your own Savings Bank Account Number, Name of the Bank & Branch and IFSC code on TA form. The admissible TA as per Government Rules will be credited to your Savings Bank Account through NEFT / RTGS mode.
12. BARC has not appointed any agency to carry out selection to this post. In case any person / agency asks for any gratification, the matter may be brought to the notice of BARC.
13. Candidate will not be allowed to enter into the examination centre after 15 minutes from the commencement of the examination.
14. To reach the Venue of examination(s) : In Mumbai city, you can travel by BEST bus, Local train, Autorickshaw or taxi, which are easily available. The nearest local railway station to the venue is Mankhurd on Harbour Line, about 2kms away.
15. R.K. Studio (Chembur) and Deonar Bus Depot are landmarks near Anushaktinagar.

From Anushaktinagar entry gate, you can reach the venue of examination(s) and Skill Test by taking autorickshaw or by walk.

(B) LEVEL - 1 OBJECTIVE TYPE WRITTEN EXAMINATION

1. Written examination will comprise of Objective type questions with multiple-choice answer.
2. Right answer carries one mark. $\frac{1}{4}$ Mark will be deducted for every wrong answer (marks will not be deducted for unattended questions).
3. Result of Level-1 exam will be declared and displayed on the notice boards on the same day and those qualified in Level-1 test will only be allowed to appear for the Level-2 exam, the next day.

(C) LEVEL - 2 DESCRIPTIVE TYPE WRITTEN EXAMINATION

1. Examination consists of two papers. Paper-I & Paper-II for a duration of 3 hours each.
2. Examination will be as per syllabus indicated in the advertisement.
3. Final Selection will be based on the Level-2 examination only.

WARNING

Please note that this admit card is only provisional and it is informed that if, any candidate is not meeting the below mentioned criteria, their candidature will stand cancelled at any stage of the selection procedure and will not be allowed to attend further stage of selection. If you do not possess any of the following criteria, you are not eligible to attend the examination and your candidature shall stand cancelled.

- Age : General candidates (including SC / ST candidates), age of the candidate as on the closing date i.e. 16/08/2016 shall be between 18 years and 28 years i.e. born between 16/08/1988 to 16/08/1998 (inclusive of both the dates) and for OBC / PWD / Widow / Divorcee(Female) candidates age relaxation will be as notified in the advertisement and accordingly age as on the closing date of online application may be calculated for determining one's eligibility for writing exam(s) and they shall produce requisite document(s) as per Government of India Rules/orders.
- Qualification : Candidate should possess minimum required qualification.
- Payment of Fees: For Gen / OBC candidates other than Women, PWD and Ex-Servicemen category, payment of fees should have been made on or before last date of closing of online application i.e. 16th August 2016 and they should produce Institute's Copy of Challan to this effect, failure of which, candidate will not be allowed to attend examination.
- Category Certificate : SC / ST / OBC / PWD / Ex-Serviceman candidates are required to produce valid Caste / Physical Disability Certificate / Proof of Ex-Serviceman, on the date of written examination.
