All the candidates are requested to bring their original documents and a copy of all documents along with them, at the time of written examination.

Instructions for Candidates

(A) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Outstation candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their stay in Chennai.
2. **Entry to the examination Hall will not be allowed without the Admit Card-cum-Call Letter.**
Those who could not upload photograph in the on-line application may affix passport size photograph on both on-line application and admit card duly attested by a Gazetted Officer.
The candidate should also bring along-with them valid photo ID proof such as Aadhar Card / Election Card / PAN Card / Driving License / Passport etc.
3. Candidates are required to preserve this Admit Card cum Call Letter for both Level-1&Level-2 examinations.
4. **Last five digit of your Application No. is your Roll No. If Your Application Number is A000141-000046 your Roll Number will be 00046.**
5. Electronic Gadgets/Cellular phones/Mobile/Pager/Calculator etc shall not be allowed in the examination hall.
6. Candidates are required to bring the following documents & testimonials (**ORIGINAL** + one **COPY** of each) at the time of appearing for Written Test:-
 - a) Print out of online application form;
 - b) Educational qualifications (SSC/HSC/Degree and further education, if any);
 - c) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC);
Candidates belonging to OBC category will have to submit OBC non-creamy layer certificate in the Central Government format issued after 31.01.2017 (i.e. the closing date of receipt of online application). Candidates are also requested to download and fill the Declaration Form for candidates seeking reservation as OBC.)

The OBC non-creamy layer certificate and the declaration form can be downloaded from the website www.recruit.barc.gov.in (Home page - Job application Download Forms – OBC non-creamy layer certificate & declaration for candidates seeking reservation as OBC). Candidates should ensure themselves that the caste name is included in the Central List of OBC by the Government of India. Candidate will not be allowed to appear for the examination if, the caste name is not listed in the Central List of OBC. Candidates may visit website www.nbc.nic.in to check their caste name in Central List.
 - d) Documentary evidence of having released/retired/discharged from Armed Forces of the Union of India as Ex-servicemen.
 - e) Disability Certificate from the appropriate authority regarding physical disability. Forms can be downloaded from the website.
 - f) **Original 'Institutional Copy' of Challan as proof payment of application fee made before the closing date of receipt of online application i.e. 31.01.2017**
 - g) Two copies of passport size photographs (same photograph) which is uploaded in the website.
 - h) "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from present employer in case of candidate working in Central / State Government / Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body.
 - i) Proof of the effect that they have been affected by 1984 riots (as applicable).
 - j) Certificate regarding domiciled in Kashmir Division from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 (if claiming age relaxation for Kashmir division).
 - k) Divorce decree in case of divorced women and women judicially separated from their husbands and who are not re-married and seeking age concession.
 - l) Any other relevant certificates (as applicable).

CANDIDATES WHO DO NOT SUBMIT THE ABOVE SAID DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FOR THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION.

7. If there is any change in name due to marriage/divorce etc., relevant documents such as Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree, any other legal document supporting change of name should be submitted.
8. Candidature to appear for the Written Test has been adjudged only on the basis of self-declaration of the candidates given in the online application and, therefore, is only provisional. The candidates may ensure that they fulfill the conditions as prescribed in the advertisement before they appear for written examination. At any stage, if it is found that the candidate is ineligible as per the eligibility criteria, the candidature of such candidate will be cancelled forthwith.
9. SC / ST candidates from outstation who are not employed in Government Sector, etc., and not in receipt of Railway concession will be paid travelling allowance as per rules for attending this examination on production of valid Caste Certificate and ticket(s) / ticket Nos. / Boarding pass (if travelled by Air). TA form can be downloaded from the website (Home page – Job application – Download Forms – travelling allowance form) the BARC website. Duly filled-in TA form along with a copy of Caste Certificate, ticket(s) & copy of Cheque-leaf / Bank Passbook should be submitted at the time of written examination. Please mention your own Savings Bank Account Number, Name of the Bank & Branch and IFSC code on TA form. The admissible TA as per Government Rules will be credited to your Savings Bank Account through NEFT / RTGS mode. TA will be paid only *once* for appearing for written exam.
10. NRB, BARCF(K) has not appointed any agency to carry out selection to this post. In case any person / agency asks for any gratification, the matter may be brought to the notice of CAO, NRB, BARCF(K).
11. Candidate will not be allowed to enter into the examination Centre after 15 minutes from commencement of the examination.

WARNING

Please note that this admit card is only provisional and it is informed that if, any candidate is not meeting the below mentioned criteria, their candidature will stand cancelled at any stage of the selection procedure and will not be allowed to attend further stage of selection. If you do not possess any of the following criteria, you are not eligible to attend the examination and your candidature shall stand cancelled.

- Age : For General candidates and ST, age as on the closing date i.e. 31.01.2017 shall be between 18 years and 27 years. For SC/OBC/PWD/Departmental candidates (Central Government Servants)/Widows, divorced women and women judicially separated from their husbands and who are not re-married age relaxation in upper limit will be as notified in the advertisement as per Govt. rules. For ex-servicemen age relaxation in upper limit will be as per the Govt. rules applicable. Accordingly, age as on the closing date of online application may be calculated for determining one's eligibility for writing exam(s) and they shall produce requisite document(s) as per Government of India Rules/orders.
- Qualification : Candidate should possess minimum required qualification i.e. A Degree (Graduate) in Arts, Science or Commerce of a recognized university or equivalent with an aggregate of 50% marks.
Candidate should have the required qualification as on the CLOSING DATE of receipt of application (31.01.2017)
- Payment of Fees: **Gen / OBC candidates (except Women / Ex-Servicemen/PWD) should produce Institute's copy of Bank Challan to the effect of payment of 'Application Fee' made on or before last date of closing of online application i.e. 31.01.2017, failing which,**

candidate will not be allowed to attend examination.
