Sealed quotations are invited on the behalf of President of India by Project Manager, NRG Proj, NRG, BARC, Trombay, Mumbai – 400 085 for the following work from contractors having adequate experience, staff, staff with valid PVC and capabilities to execute such magnitude of similar work and who have similar experience with different units of Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd. (NPCIL), Public sector undertakings, reputed public/private organizations etc.

Scope of work:

"Refurbishment and repair of existing MS structure at EETF."

Period of completion: 11 Months

The tenderer may contact on Telephone Nos. 2559 5505/ 2559 6776 to make necessary security permits for submission of application for tender/issuance of enquiry.

Notes & General Instructions:

- a) Please clearly mention on the sealed envelope of your quotation the following
 - i) Quotation for the work – Name of work.
 - ii) Tender notice no./Inquiry no.
 - iii) Name and address of firm, etc, Otherwise the tender/quotation shall be summarily rejected.
- b) Full payment will be given only after completion of work in accordance with the rules in force regarding the minor fabrication works on the submission of following documents. i) Bill in triplicate ii) Work completion certificate iii) Advanced stamped receipt for full payment.
- c) Interested parties must visit site to gauge the magnitude and type of work and collect a copy of blank BOQ and/or Technical specifications from office of Shri Neeraj Kumar, EETF,WIP-Complex BARC, Trombay, Mumbai – 400 085.
Last date for entertaining such queries shall be 15/11/2021 up to 15:00 hrs, only on working days
- d) All taxes should be mentioned clearly. The taxes, levies etc. if any shall be mentioned separately.

- e) Quotations should be in printed letter head, signed by the proprietor or authorized person with company seal.
- f) The contractor shall quote the price after studying the enquiry and technical specification.
- g) Any deviation from the specification shall be mentioned in your offer.
- h) The required validity period of the offer is **45 days**. The contractor shall specify the validity of offer in the quotation.
- i) The contractor shall mention the work completion period clearly in the quotation.

Last date for receipt of sealed quotation is 22/11/2021 up to 12:00 Hrs.

Sealed quotation will be received up to 12:00 hrs on 22/11/2021 and will be opened on the same day at 14:00 hrs.

1. Initial Eligibility Criteria:

- i. The bidder shall be compliant to the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 (as amended from time to time) issued Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry. Also, bidder must submit undertaking along with bid for local content of 100 % offered in subject tender.
- ii. Only 'Class-I local supplier' as defined Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017, are eligible to participate for subject tender

2. Additional Clauses:

- I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. Certificate for the same attached as Annexure I(a) has to be signed and submitted by bidder before opening of the tender.
- II. "Bidder" (including the term 'tender', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or officer controlled by such person, participation in a procurement process.
- III. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means :-
 - a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
 - e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
 - f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
 - g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

IV. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (III) above will be as under:

- 1) In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership interest or who exercises control through other means.

Explanation: -

- a) “Controlling ownership interest” means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five percent of shares or capital or profits of the company.
 - b) “Control shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholders agreements or voting agreements.
- 2) In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;
 - 3) In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of individuals,
 - 4) Where no natural person is identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;
 - 5) In case of trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall include identification of the author of the trust, the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.

V. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person.

VI. The successful bidder shall not be allowed to subcontract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority. Certificate for the same attached as Annexure I(b) has to be signed and submitted by bidder before opening of the tender.

VII. Eligible source countries: Any Bidder, from a country which shares a land border with India must comply to the Order (Public Procurement No.1) & Order (Public Procurement No. 2) issued by Public Procurement Division, Department of Expenditure, ministry of Finance, Government of India vide F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 and its addendum from time to time. Also, the bidder shall provide a certificate as per Performa given ‘**Annexure I(c)**’. If such declaration or certificate is found to be false or to be incorrect at any time of submission of Bid or after awarding the Contract, then the said Contract will be terminated, along with such other actions as may be permissible under the relevant law of India.

A) Installation Practices:

1. The contractor shall use proper electrical plug/sockets. Use of loose wiring will not be permitted.
2. The contractor shall use all safety gears like helmets, safety belts, safety shoes etc. and follow safe installation practices. All the safety precautions shall be meticulously followed, the instructions given by Engr. In Charge & Safety Coordinator from time to time shall be abided.

3. Installation shall be neat and workmanship shall be of excellent quality.
4. The Contractor should supply and install all the fixtures, which may not be specifically mentioned in above, but necessary for the completeness of the work, without any additional cost.
5. All the accessories such as clamps, MS boxes, MS Angles, nuts bolts and screws, fixers, ravel plugs, etc. should be supplied by the Contractor.
6. The contractor shall be responsible for any loss or damage during transportation, handling and storage of materials and/or any components.
7. The installation of the above work should be as per the guidance of Engineer-in-charge of work.

B) Inspection & Testing:

1. All the items / materials shall be inspected at Contractor's end/Sourcing Agency before dispatch. Functional tests shall be repeated at site after installation & commissioning, but before final acceptance.
2. Inspection and defects rectifications: -Any defects observed or detected during inspection shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost and in procedure acceptable to Engineer-in-charge/dept. engineers at no extra cost.

C) Working Conditions:

The contractor shall arrange all equipment and personnel required for the successful completion of the work. Contractor shall clean the site after work and dispose the waste generated properly. Contractor shall stick to the schedule given and complete the work before work order expiry.

Safety and security rules: --

a)	Police verification certificate is required for all workers and supervisor deployed at the site.
b)	Security rules and transport rules at BARC, Trombay premises shall be strictly followed.
c)	Labours under 18 years shall not be allowed to work at site.
d)	Department shall not be responsible for any injury caused to contractor workforce due to any reason / unsafe working procedures followed by his personnel while working at site.
e)	Covid 19 Guide lines issued by BARC/ Statuary Authorities shall be scrupulously followed by Contractor and his persons.

Note: Contractor shall have readily available deployable work force with valid PVC.

1. Supplier shall bring all requisite mounting accessories, fittings, connectors /adapters etc for associated works.
2. All handling equipment, scaffoldings, tools and tackles, ladders, other machines, safety belts, welding machines etc required for the erection work shall be arranged by the Contractor.
3. All the clauses of BARC Safety Manual should be followed at any time during the work. The Manual is available on BARC website for reference.
4. The vendor should arrange transport of materials required for carrying out the work in advance i.e. prior to starting off the field jobs. Please note **materials /tools etc entry to the site & their exits** is subjected to **security checks & procedure laid down by BARC security sections** & shall be strictly followed during the site execution. Electricity and Water will be provided free of cost for the above work.

5. The vendor shall arrange adequate accident insurance coverage of his personnel. BARC shall not be responsible for any liability arising out of any accident / injury caused to vendor's personal while executing the work.
6. To the extent possible the work shall be carried during the normal working hours i.e. 9.30 A.M to 5.30 P.M. Monday to Friday. Prior permission will be required to work on holidays and beyond office hours on working days & holidays.
7. This work involves working in restricted area with security restrictions on entry of workers, working time etc.
8. All the workers and their supervisors need to have police verification done and cleared.
9. Contractor shall at his own cost, make arrangements for transport of his personnel, materials, tools etc. to and from the site.
