


**Subject: Preventive Measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 –Govt. of Maharashtra Order dated 12.05.2021 'BREAK THE CHAIN'- Regarding.**

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The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No.16/6/2020-SCS/COVID-19/Vol.III/5240 dated 22.04.2021 and OM No.16/6/2020-SCS/COVID-19/Vol.III/5491 dated 30.04.2021 on the captioned subject and forward herewith a copy of Government of Maharashtra (GoM) Order No.DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1 dated 12.05.2021 under "BREAK THE CHAIN" extending restrictions beyond 7 AM on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 till 7 AM on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2021 for information and compliance by DAE and its Constituent Units/PSUs/Aided Institutions located within the State of Maharashtra.

2. The attendance in DAE and its Constituent Units / PSUs / Aided Institutions located in the State of Maharashtra shall continue to be regulated as per GoM Order dated 21.04.2021, circulated vide DAE OM No.16/6/2020-SCS/COVID-19/Vol.III/5240 dated 22.04.2021, which will remain in force till 7 AM on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2021, or until further orders whichever is earlier.
3. All "Essential Services" which have been exempted such as Health Care, Fire, Security, Transport, etc., shall function with full strength.
4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.

Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) Order No. 40-3/2020-PM-1 (A) Dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020, 11<sup>th</sup> May 2020, 17<sup>th</sup> May 2020, 20<sup>th</sup> May 2020, 30<sup>th</sup> May 2020, 29<sup>th</sup> June 2020, 29<sup>th</sup> July 2020, 29<sup>th</sup> August 2020, 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and 27<sup>th</sup> October 2020, 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2020, 28<sup>th</sup> December, 2020, 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 and 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2021

Whereas, in exercise of the powers, conferred under the Disaster Management Act 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee had issued an Order dated 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 and 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 (extended by order dated 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2020, 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2020, 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2020 and 29<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 and 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2021, 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 5<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 and 21<sup>st</sup> April and 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2021) for containment of COVID 19 in the State for the period upto 7 AM on


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15<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 and issued revised guidelines by including certain activities from time to time vide above mentioned orders.

Whereas the State Government is satisfied that the State of Maharashtra is continued to be threatened with the spread of COVID-19 virus, and therefore it is imperative to continue emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of virus, the Government in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, read with all other enabling provisions of The Disaster Management Act, 2005, finds it is necessary to continue the enforcement of the current restrictions, along with certain additional restrictions, throughout the State beyond 7 AM on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 till 7 AM on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2021 to break the chain of transmission effectively.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and the powers, conferred under The Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee, hereby extends all the restrictions that have been imposed vide 'Break the Chain' orders dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 21<sup>st</sup> April and 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 along with all additions and clarifications issued thereof as well as imposes following additional restrictions in the State till 7 AM on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2021.

1. Any person entering the State of Maharashtra by any mode of transport will have to carry a negative RTPCR test report which will have to be issued from upto a maximum of 48 hours before the time of his entry into Maharashtra.
2. All the restrictions that have been made applicable to persons arriving from places of 'Sensitive Origins' as per the orders dated 18<sup>th</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 will be applicable to anyone arriving from any part of the country into the State.
3. In the case of cargo carriers, not more than two people (Driver + Cleancr/ helper) may be allowed to travel in the same. If these cargo carriers are originating from outside the state, these may be allowed to enter into the State with a negative RTPCR test which will have to be issued from upto a maximum of 48 hours before the time of entry into Maharashtra and which will be valid for 7 days.
4. Local DMA should keep special vigil over rural markets and APMCs and ensure Covid Appropriate Behaviour and if it finds any such place as difficult to manage and discipline to ensure non-spread of Covid epidemic, local DMA may decide on a case by case basis to shut these or may impose further restrictions.





5. Milk collection, transport and processing may be allowed without restrictions though its retail sale shall be allowed subject to restrictions imposed on shops dealing with essential items or through home delivery.

6. Personnel engaged in Airport and Port services and needed for movement of cargo related to medicines or equipments needed for Covid management will be allowed to travel in local, mono and metro services.

7. Local DMA may decide to impose further restrictions generally or to specific sectors or specific areas with intimation to SDMA and shall give at least 48 hours of public notice before making such further restrictions applicable.
