- 2. Detail of Domestic Pest Control works to be performed under this contract is mentioned in Annexure- 2 and General Terms and Conditions for this contract is mentioned in Annexure-3.
- 3. Eligibility Criteria:

Technical Bid and Financial Bid shall be placed in separate closed envelopes and Part 'A' (Technical Bid) and Part 'B' (Financial Bid) shall be boldly mentioned on these envelopes. Said separate envelopes shall be kept in a sealed envelope and shall be submitted.

Note: Initial disqualification Criteria as given below:

- i. The interchange of content in either envelope shall lead to disqualify of the bidder.
- ii. In case if both Technical Bid & Price Bid if placed together in a closed envelope shall also lead to disqualification.

4. The application should be submitted along with satisfactory proof of:

- (a) Registration in appropriate class of contractors, if any.
- (b) Latest bank Solvency Certificate of a Nationalised Bank / Scheduled Bank for a minimum 40% of estimated cost and should NOT be older than one year from the date of opening of tender.
- (c) Average Annual Financial Turnover on works should be at least 100% of estimated cost during last 3 years ending March 31 of preceding year in which tender is invited. This should be duly audited by a registered Chartered Accountant.
- (d) Should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during last five years ending March 31 of preceding year in which tender is invited.
- (e) List of similar works completed in last 3 years indicating:

(i) Agency for whom executed, (ii) Value of work Order/ Purchase Order and (iii) Stipulated and actual time of completion.

(f) List of works in hand indicating:

(i) Agency (ii) Value of work and (iii) Stipulated time of completion/present position.

- (g) Certificates of Work Experience / Performance Certificates.
- (h) Certificates of GST (Goods and Services Tax) Registration Certificate.
- (i) Certificates of PAN (Permanent Account Number) Registration.
- (j) Certificates of EPFO registration certificate.
- (k) Certificates of ESIC registration certificate.

The bidder shall submit proof of satisfactorily completion of similar works (certification of performance by client of the works to be submitted for proof) Work Order/ Purchase Order for a value of anyone as mentioned below:

i. One Work Order/ Purchase Order ≥ 10.4 Lakhs

OR

ii. Two Work orders/ Purchase orders ≥ 7.8 Lakhs

OR

iii. Three Work orders/ Purchase orders \geq 5.2 Lakhs

For the purpose, 'cost of work' shall mean gross value of the completed work including the cost of materials supplied by the Govt./Client, but excluding those supplied free of cost. For the purpose of clause Similar Works means "Domestic Pest Control works". The similar works should have been executed in India.

5. Bidder should be a registered firm in India. Joint Ventures and or Consortiums are not acceptable.

Conditions:

- **6.** After opening of Part 'A' of tender, Head, APD may constitute an evaluation team which will evaluate the capability of the tenderers (and may visit selected worksites of on-going/completed works of the tenderers, if required) based on the following conditions:
 - a) Financial capability and their turnover during the last 3 years.
 - b) Technical capabilities of the company in the light of subject work.
 - c) Nature of similar works executed by the tenderer during last 3 years.
 - d) Necessary Resource required by company to carry out the subject work.
 - e) Tendency of the company with regard to making extraneous claims and disputes.
 - f) Tendency of the company to award the work on back-to-back /subletting.
- 7. No modifications in the tender shall be allowed after opening Part 'A' (Technical Bid) of the Tender.
- 8. If any information furnished by the applicant is found to be incorrect at a later stage, they shall be liable to be debarred from tendering / taking up works in BARC in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before start of work, the Head, APD may CANCEL your bid.
- **9.** The time allowed for carrying out the work will be reckoned from the 15th day after date of written order to commence the work or from the first day of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
- 10. Tender will be kept valid for 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the last date of submission of tenders.
- 11. The contractor whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish by way of security deposit for the due fulfilment of his contract, such as an amount to 2.5% of the tendered value of work. In addition, the contractor shall be required to deposit an amount equal to 5% of the tendered value of the contract as Performance Security before commencement of the work but not later than stipulated date of commencement. Performance Security of 5% can also be accepted in the form of Bank guarantees (in case Performance Security exceeds 1.00 Lakhs), fixed deposit receipts of Scheduled Bank or in the form of Government Securities.
- 12. The Security Deposit will be collected by deductions @ 2.5 % of the gross amount of the running bill of the contractors till the total security deposit recovered will amount to 2.5% of the tendered value of work. The Security deposit will also be accepted in the form of Governments Securities, Fixed deposit Receipts of Scheduled Bank and Nationalised Bank.

- **13.** If the successful tenderer, fails to furnish the prescribed performance guarantee on or before stipulated dates of commencement the department (BARC) shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to CANCEL your bid.
- **14.** The acceptance of tender shall rest with department which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received, without assigning any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
- **15.** Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- **16.** On acceptance of the tender, the name of the accredited representative(s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from the Head, APD shall be communicated to the Engineer-Incharge.
- **17.** The department reserves the right to accept the whole or only part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rates quoted.
- 18. Taxes details: -

i) GST shall mean Goods and Service Tax-Central, State and Inter State. Goods &Services Tax (GST) or any other tax applicable in respect of inputs procured by the contractor for this contract shall be payable by the Contractor and Government will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same. However, component of GST at time of supply of service (as provided in CGST Act 2017) provided by the contract shall be varied if different from that applicable on the last date of receipt of tender including extension if any.

ii) Income tax, cess and any other applicable taxes as applicable shall be deducted as per Government directives from each bill paid to the contractor.

iii) Contractor should be registered under EPF & ESIC and shall pay EPF & ESIC of contract workers to concerned Department and it will be reimbursed to him by the Department after satisfying that it has been actually and genuinely paid by the contractor. The bidder should not consider EPF & ESIC in his rates. Contractors shall comply provisions of the EPF Act, 1952 in respect of all the eligible employees / workers/ labours and submit the documentary proof regularly with every Bill along with monthly presenty of workers.

Further, the tenderer shall not be allowed to participate in the re-tendering process of the work.

In case of receipt of any adverse charter and antecedent remarks/ notification against the Contractor/ Company/ firm/proprietor and/ or his contract personnel, consequent to the security vetting, BARC reserves absolute right to terminate the contract forthwith without assigning reason/ show cause notice. Under the circumstance the Contractor will have no right to claim good any losses/liability that may be incurred as consequence to the above action initiated by BARC. BARC also reserves the right to forfeit in part/full performance security and/ or security deposit in possession of the Government for failure on the part of the contractor to abide/adhere the contact terms or/ and to the Security instruction issued by DAE/ BARC from time to time.

19. Instructions:

Tenders will be received up to time & date as mentioned above. Part A will be opened on the time & date as mentioned above. After opening of Part- A, for evaluation, the contractor's on going / completed work sites & offices may be visited and their Technical Bid related documents shall be evaluated and accordingly tenderers will be qualified / disqualified by the Competent Authority. The Part 'B' (Financial Bid) of the qualified tenderers shall then be opened at notified date and time. Date of opening of Part 'B' (Financial Bid) will be intimated to all bidders by email.

A. Special instructions to the contractor

- 1. The tenderer is requested to visit the site to acquaint him with the site conditions, working conditions, approaches, availability of materials and other facilities for his labour force before submitting the tender. They should have license for the pest control work.
- 2. Location& scope of work Project: Domestic pest control in entire EHPPL premises, BARC, Kalyan

B. Specifications for 'Domestic Pest Control at EHPPL premises:

- 1. **Domestic Pest Control**: Mass treatment should consist of spraying the contractor's special insecticide formulations, which should destroy the pests and leave a residual action, which should prevent re-infestation for a long period. During the period of contract regular and continuous domestic pest control operations using odourless domestic pesticides/termiticides such as Solfac, Regent, Lakshya, Premise and Termex-350 Sc or equivalent or other suggested for control or eradicate pests from DSC barracks , Canteen, Administrative building, Fire station, Security Guard house, Security cabin, all laboratories at EHPPL premises, should be kept free from pests. While spraying, more attention is required to crucial points such as toilets, drains, undersides of bathrooms, nooks & corners, gutters, sewers, kitchen stores, furniture, inside shelves, cupboard and drawers and behind curtains etc. and control of all pests such as Cockroaches, Insects, Rodents, Mosquitoes, Termites, Borers, Lizards, Ants. Honeybees, Bugs, Wasps, Pigeons, Flies, Silver fishes, Crabs, Bats etc. by use of Odourless chemical spray methods, baits, traps or any other effective methods. Total area to be kept free from pest is about 26400 m² but based on the frequency & priority basis.
- 2. Number of treatments for domestic pest control: 72 pest control treatments are to be carried out during the 24 months contract period i. e. three pest control treatment/service/operation are to be carried out monthly to DSC barracks, Canteen, Administrative building, Fire station, Guard house, Security cabin, all laboratories at EHPPL premises. If required, contractor shall have to carry out additional treatment without any extra cost.
- 3. **Rodent Control:** Adopting chemical and non-chemical methods which should comprises of rat repellent, rat proofing, trapping, pre-baiting, hold baiting, anti-coagulant rodenticides (Rodufarin, Aluminium Phosphide, pellets for burrows fumigation etc.). Contractor should have sufficient number of rat traps all the time and variety of baits should be used to trap the rodents. Rat/Rodents found dead in the building during contract period should be removed and disposed of/buried immediately by the contractor. In case any snake menace occurred inside the building, the contractor should use snake repellent to tackle the problem. **240 rodent control operations are to be carried out during the 24 months contract period**
- 4. Bee Hive: If any bee hive found in the BARC premises at any height should be removed by the contractor. The proper care (for working at heights and against biting of bees) should be taken during operation and only trained staff should be engaged for this purpose. Required safety measures should be adopted. 30 Bee hive removal operations are to be carried out during the 24 months contract period

C. General Terms and Conditions for Biennial Contract for Domestic Pest Control at EHPPL, BARC, Kalyan near village – Chincholi, Tehsil – Kalyan as follows:

- 1. **Only Pest Control license holder firm are eligible** to quote the present domestic pest control AMC work at EHPPL BARC, near village Chincholi.
- 2. For carrying out the complete pest control work the contractor shall have to engage a semi skilled labour to conduct pest control works at EHPPL site at given frequency from time to time. The contractor person shall visit at least once in a day. Apart from visits for pest control works at given frequency, the contractor person shall visit on call from site in case of rodent is trapped.
- 3. Total area to be kept free from pest is about 26400 m^2 but based on the frequency & priority basis.
- 4. The contractor shall pay the wages to the labourers as prescribed by Government of India from time to time. Contractor is solely responsible for all documents which are required during Labour Inspector visit at site.
- 5. The contractor shall give the labourers suitable uniform/dress to identify their staff by security and other departmental personnel in BARC premises.
- 6. The contractor will be responsible for compilation of all laws and other rules/laws of Government of India/ State Government relating to this contract.
- 7. The contractor will be allowed to start the work only after receiving the Security Vetting of the firm. The contractor shall obtain **Police Verification Certificate**, **necessary security passes for his staff**, and shall follow strictly all the security guidelines of the department.
- 8. All liabilities arising out of accident or death of any personnel while duty shall be borne by the contractor. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any injury to or death of any third person caused due to contractor or its staff's negligence.
- 9. The contractor and its staff shall take proper and reasonable precautions to preserve from loss, destruction, waste or misuse the areas of responsibility given to them by the Department.
- 10. The contractor shall not employ any person below the age of 18 years. Only physically and medically fit personnel shall be employed for the duty.
- 11. The department shall not be under any obligation for providing employment to any of the worker of the contractor during and after the expiry of the contract.
- 12. The contractor must complete all the operations in time as per the monthly schedule of treatment for the all installations covered in it; if the work of any treatment/service/operation found to be non-executed to any installations out of the scheduled installations, penalty will be imposed for the non-performance and the decision of imposing penalty is reserved with the Competent Authority. Penalty may be charged to the contractor at the rate of cost of operation with additional 50% penal charges for the month for which bill is submitted.

- 13. Payment in respect of pest control treatment for the buildings and other areas in this contract will be made on receipt of monthly bill in duplicate after completion of monthly services satisfactory. The Government shall not pay any amount over and above the accepted rate for any reason whatsoever.
- 14. The contractor's sole of responsibility is to provide all required safety their workers and safety of the tools, chemicals/pesticides and sufficient rat traps in the storage room provided them during the contract period at their own cost.
- 15. The trapped rats should be collected regularly from various places and be killed them dipping in water taken in the bucket and dispose them by burying.
- 16. The contractor shall have to make arrangement for providing variety food items/ bait to attract the rats trapping in the traps.
- 17. The contractor shall have to keep sufficient tools, equipments and cupboards for storage of pesticides on the site at their own cost and responsibility and after completion of contract unused pesticides, cupboards etc. can be taken out from side by contractor on their own cost.
- 18. For effective control of all pests mentioned in the description of work in the work order, odourless chemical spray methods, baits, traps or any other effective method should be carried out.
- 19. Safety gears like hand glows (cotton and rubber), safety goggles, mask during spraying, safety shoes etc. required for the work personnel during pest control work shall be in the scope of Contractor.
- 20. Labours deployed by contractor for present work shall have to sign in the Presenty Muster/ Register provided at the site office.
- 21. GST as per applicable subject to production of GST Registration Certificate.
- 22. The contract can be terminated at any time if the work is not found satisfactory.
